

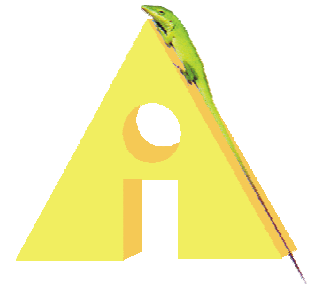

Call for Papers



The 22nd International Florida Artificial Intelligence Research Society Conference (FLAIRS-22) will be held 19th-21st May 2009 at the Sundial Beach and Golf Resort (<http://www.sundialresort.com>) on Sanibel Island, Florida, USA. FLAIRS-22 will feature technical papers, special tracks, and invited speakers. Sanibel is a barrier island lying on the Gulf coast of Florida near Fort Myers. Although an island in name, Sanibel is linked to the mainland by a causeway and a bridge, making access to Sanibel easy. Sanibel has beautiful beaches that are world renowned for their sea shells. Indeed, Sanibel boasts the only museum in the world dedicated to the study of shells. Sanibel is home to numerous bird species, alligators, and even the occasional crocodile. Submission Instructions

Submitted papers must be original, and not submitted concurrently to a journal or another conference. **Full papers** may be up to **6 pages**, and **poster papers** up to **2 pages**. Papers must be in AAAI format, and submitted as PDF through the EasyChair conference system which can be accessed through the main conference web site (<http://www.FLAIRS-22.info>). The proceedings of FLAIRS will be published by the AAAI. Authors of accepted papers will be required to sign a form transferring copyright of their contribution to AAAI. An author of each accepted paper is required to register, attend, and present the paper at FLAIRS.
